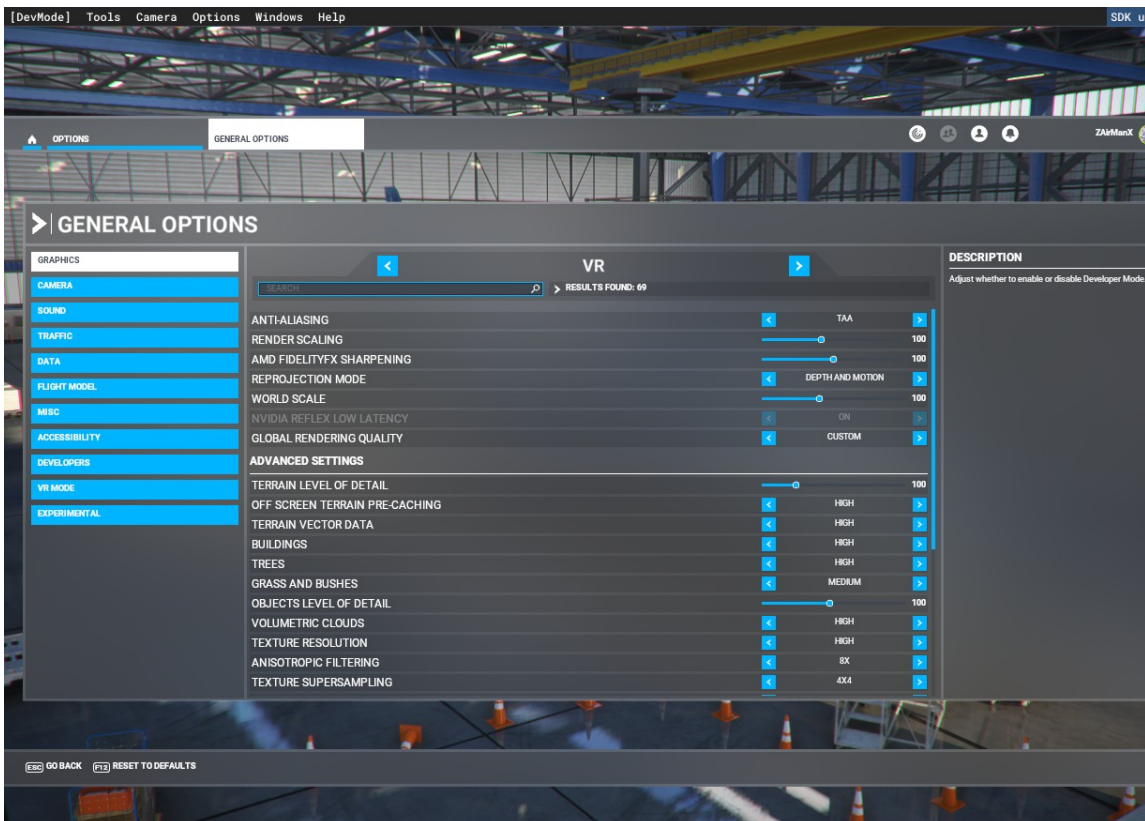


CTD with DX12 and TAA selected for both PC and VR.
